

# LA LOVES ALEX'S LEMONADE

**L**os Angeles Restaurateur Caroline Styne, her Chef/ Partner Suzanne Goin and Chef David Lentz (The Hungry Cat) gathered culinary greats from throughout the US to help raise funds and awareness for Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation with the second annual LA Loves Alex's Lemonade on November 6, 2011.

Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation ([www.alexlemonade.org](http://www.alexlemonade.org)) was created by Alexandra "Alex" Scott, who was diagnosed with childhood cancer just before her first birthday. When she was four, she set up a front-yard lemonade stand to raise money to find a cure, raising \$2,000 in one day. Alex passed away in 2004, at the age of eight, but her determination and strength live on through Alex's Lemonade Stands set up throughout the country. Children all over the country set up lemonade stands each year and today more than \$45 million has been raised to help find a cure for all children with cancer.

With more than 1,000 attendees including Honorary Host Neil Patrick Harris, the LA event raised more than \$400,000 for ALSF.
